Stewart's Lager is a local independent brewery producing multi award winning beers. This fantastic local lager is crisp and very drinkable. Our best selling draft beer that was inspired by the Makars and we love them!

##### Stewart's Session IPA (gluten free) (3.7%)

Citrusy hop aroma develops into a mouthwatering juiciness and finishes with a refreshingly bitter bite. 100% Scottish barley gives a big, satisfying, full-bodied beer.

##### Pilot BLØND Oats IPA (4.%)

Blønd is an easy-drinking session IPA packed with malted oats and dry-hopped with Mosaic and Galaxy for a full-on tropical fruit aromas.

##### Pilot Leith Lager (gluten free) (4.1%)

Pilot's flagship lager; clean, crisp & full of Leith character. Scottish pale malt blends with Czech Saaz hops to create a classic lager that is flavoursome yet easy drinking.

##### Pilot Stout (gluten free) (4.0%)

Everything a good stout should be; rich, bold, roasty & smooth, but at just 4%, it's easy drinking. Maris Otter gives a subtle biscuit base & layers of increasingly darker malts build up chocolate, coffee & toasty notes.

##### Thistly Cross Traditional Cider (4.4%)

Scotland's best loved cider and made from apples grown less than 30 miles from where you are sitting (gluten free).

### LIND & LIME GIN

Our local friends at Port of Leith Distillery bring you a fantastic example of Edinburgh heritage from the historic distilling district of Leith. Their balanced classic London dry gin uses 7 botanicals; juniper, coriander, angelica, liquorice, orris, fresh lime peel & peppercorns. Very accessible & well received..

#### BOTTLED BEERS/CIDERS



Jump Ship Brewing was founded in 2019 by local brewer & sailor Sonja Mitchell. None of the low alcohol beers Sonja tasted could match the amazing Scottish craft beers. Creating great LA beers is surprisingly difficult but in 2021 the Jump Ship team won best no-low alcohol lager at the World Beer Awards. Not bad for a wee start-up from Edinburgh!

##### Yardarm Lager (gluten free) (330ml) £4.50

Awarded the best non-alcoholic lager in the world at the World Beer Awards 2021, our Yardarm lager is crisp and lively, with a perfect balance of biscuity malt and citrusy hops. Zesty, refreshing and exceedingly drinkable

##### Steamboat Hazy Pale Ale (gluten free) (330ml) £4.50

Juicy, tropical flavours balanced by a smooth, pillowy mouthfeel & gentle finish, this is the perfect beer to settle back with in the sun. This beer will keep you beaming, not steaming.

##### Thistly Cross Elderflower Cider (gluten free) (440ml) (<0.5%) £4.50

A gem drink from our local craft Cider experts, bright, floral elderflower aromas perfectly balanced with crisp, juicy apple. It delivers that unmistakable delicious Thistly character. Absolutely stunning product, well-done guys!

##### Darjeeling Kombucha Tea (330ml) £5

Dark & fruity with notes of vine fruits. From the Darjeeling district in the Himalayas. Floral aroma & delicate, complex taste that can vary with the season..

##### Sencha Green Kombucha Tea (330ml) £5

Bright, slightly grassy flavour with subtle sweet & umami notes. Sencha tea is a popular type of Japanese green tea known for its refreshing taste & high levels of antioxidants.

##### Oolong Kombucha Tea (330ml) £5

A great & subtle replacement to champagne! Oolong tea is celebrated for its complex flavours, which fall between the freshness of green tea & the richness of black tea.

Bon Accord drinks were founded in Arbroath in 1903, their iconic glass bottles were seen across Scotland for generations. These days their soft drinks are 100% naturally sweetened with fruit juice (no added sugar). Their drinks are a great alternative to alcoholic drinks that perfectly pair with our dishes..

##### Rhubarb Soda (330ml) £4

Full flavoured & fruity with balanced sweetness, we suggest it with our Mushroom dishes. Particularly good with Haggis or as a refreshing traditional drink that you can nurse over a chat.

### 'OOR' SCOTTISH WHISKY

##### LEITH EXPORT CO. TABLE WHISKY (35ml) £7.00

Possibly the easiest drinking whisky in Scotland & take on the concept of a "table beer" by our friends at Port of Leith Distillery. An easy drinking whisky to be shared around the table. Virgin oak/sherry make this highly recommended.

##### Glenkinchie 12 Year Old (35ml) £7.50

The nose is quite light, yet fragrant, the palate is fruity with notes of Madeira & sweet stewed fruits. A hint of calvados & tannic oak line the mouth. There is a freshness & roundness to this dram. The finish is of medium length with notes of cereal & fresh greenness.

##### Loch Lomond 12 Year Old (35ml) £7.50

Crafted in the shadow of Ben Lomond. This Single Malt delivers delicious notes of peach & pear layered with vanilla sweetness & a gentle hint of smoke. Their Master Blender signs each bottle as a personal assurance of quality.

##### Balvenie Double Wood (35ml) £8.00

12 year old, sweet fruit & oloroso sherry notes, layered with honey & vanilla. Smooth & mellow on the palate, with beautifully combined flavours – nutty sweetness, cinnamon spiciness & proportioned layer of sherry.

##### Glenmorangie 10 Year Old (35ml) £8.00

Over 175 years ago, the "original" is known throughout the world for its mellow tones and delicacy of flavour. Smooth with a rush of citrus, then holds your attention with layers of flavour, from orange to honey and creamy vanilla & peach.

##### Tomatin 12 Year Old (35ml) £8.50

In memory of somebody very special & sailing adventures on the West Coast of Scotland. Classically smooth, matured in ex-Bourbon/Spanish Sherry casks. Aromas of wild heather, pine & cedar sweeten to reveal notes of crème caramel, apples, pears & mango.

##### Tobermory Isle of Mull 12 (35ml) £8.50

From the oldest distilleries in Scotland which sits at the centre of the vibrant island community. Sweet orange and citrus, creamy caramel and rich vanilla with spicy hints of cinnamon and clove.

##### Bruichladdich Classic Laddie (35ml) £9.00

Crafted by arguably the most famous Master Distiller ever Jim McEwan. Matured for its entire life by the shores of Lochindaal/Islay. It is a testament to the quality of Scottish ingredients. Smooth, malty, sweet with a wonderful nose, no harshness on the palate & a lingering smooth finish.
